

Characteristics of the miraculous

1. **Now**-“Now” is the overwhelming, dominating EXPECTANCY and DEMAND upon the GLORY, SPIRIT OF GOD, invisible and EARTH TO MANIFEST the Heavenly.
Jesus said to Peter in Matt. 26:52, 53: “NOW and PRESENTLY” regarding His divine Help. He was in the “NOW and PRESENTLY”. We should approach the miraculous similarly.

2. It is never “too” with the miraculous:

It is never too hard (Gen. 18:14)

It is never too late (Mrk. 5:35-43, Jhn. 11:21-45)

It is never too big (1 Sam. 17:4-9, 23, 24, 33-51)

It is never too bad

It is never too much

It is never too old (Zacharias, Elizabeth, Abe, Sara)

It is never too young (Jer. 1:5-7, Luke 1:44, 1 Sam. 16:11, 12; 17:33, 42-44)

It is never too extreme (II Kings 7:1, 2, 18,19)

It is never too long (Mark 5:25-29, John 5:5-9)

It is never too many

It is never too far

3. It is never impossible (Luke 1:37, Mark 10:27)

“Impossible is the ground floor, the first rung on the ladder (John 2:1-8, 2 Kings 5:6-8), the beginning with God and then up from there.

4. Dare to go “there”-**take hold and be bold**-Not ashamed but Boldly

5. God connected, God conscious, God controlled, God coerced, God led, God minded, God filled, God thankful, God centered (I Kings 18:36-38, John 11:41-44, Eph. 5:18-20; Acts 4:24-33, Acts 9:37-42, Daniel 6:10, 11, 22-28, Acts 2:22, Acts 10:38)
